a Doctorate degree in canon law from
the Catholic University of America.

Ordained a priest for the Erie Diocese
on May 15, 1981, he worked in the
Tribunal, later serving as Judicial
Vicar, Director of the Office of
Conciliation & Arbitration, and Vicar
for Canonical Affairs.

Since April 19, 2011, he has served
as bishop of the Altoona-Johnstown
Diocese.

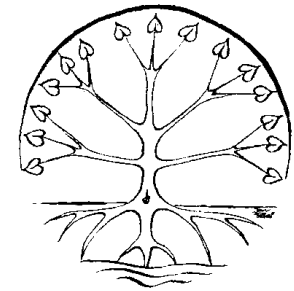
